



Organic grape growing goes one step further whereby only natural ingredients are used to nurture the soil and vineyard. It is about keeping a natural balance in the vineyard and the surrounding area.

Eg. Compost is spread over the base of the vineyard.

Nutrients and minerals leach into the soil.

A crushed quartz solution is sprayed in the vineyard to prevent mildew on the grapes.
